The designation of AE-C can only be used by individuals who have taken and passed the National Asthma Educator Certification Board (NAECB) examination and is an indicator of a higher level of preparation as an asthma educator. The mission of the NAECB is "to promote optimal asthma management and quality of life among individuals with asthma, their families and communities, by advancing excellence in asthma education through the certified asthma educator process".

The AE-C exam now includes questions related to the newest National Asthma Education and Prevention Program (NAEPP) Expert Panel III (EPR #) report. The Asthma Coalition of Texas is pleased to present a review course designed to help prepare asthma educators to take this exam. The content is based upon the exam matrix developed by the NAECB (www.naecb.org) and is written and presented by individuals holding the AE-C designation.

This eight hour course will cover how to take the exam, pathophysiology, triggers and avoidance measures, medication, objective measures of lung function, devices history and cultural aspects, educational needs, asthma actions plans, and organizational issues.
