# Prescribed Pediatric Extended Care Centers (PPECC).

#### What is a PPECC?

Prescribed Pediatric Extended Care Centers (PPECCs) may help you care for your child with medically complex health problems. These care centers allow qualifying children from 0-20 years old to get daily medical care in a non-residential (non-household) place.

- Your child's doctor will need to order (prescribe) this service
- When prescribed, the child can be there up to 12 hours each day
- During their stay, they will get care in these areas:
  - o medical
  - nursing
  - psychosocial
  - therapeutic
  - o developmental

The care will fit their medical health problem and developmental stage.
