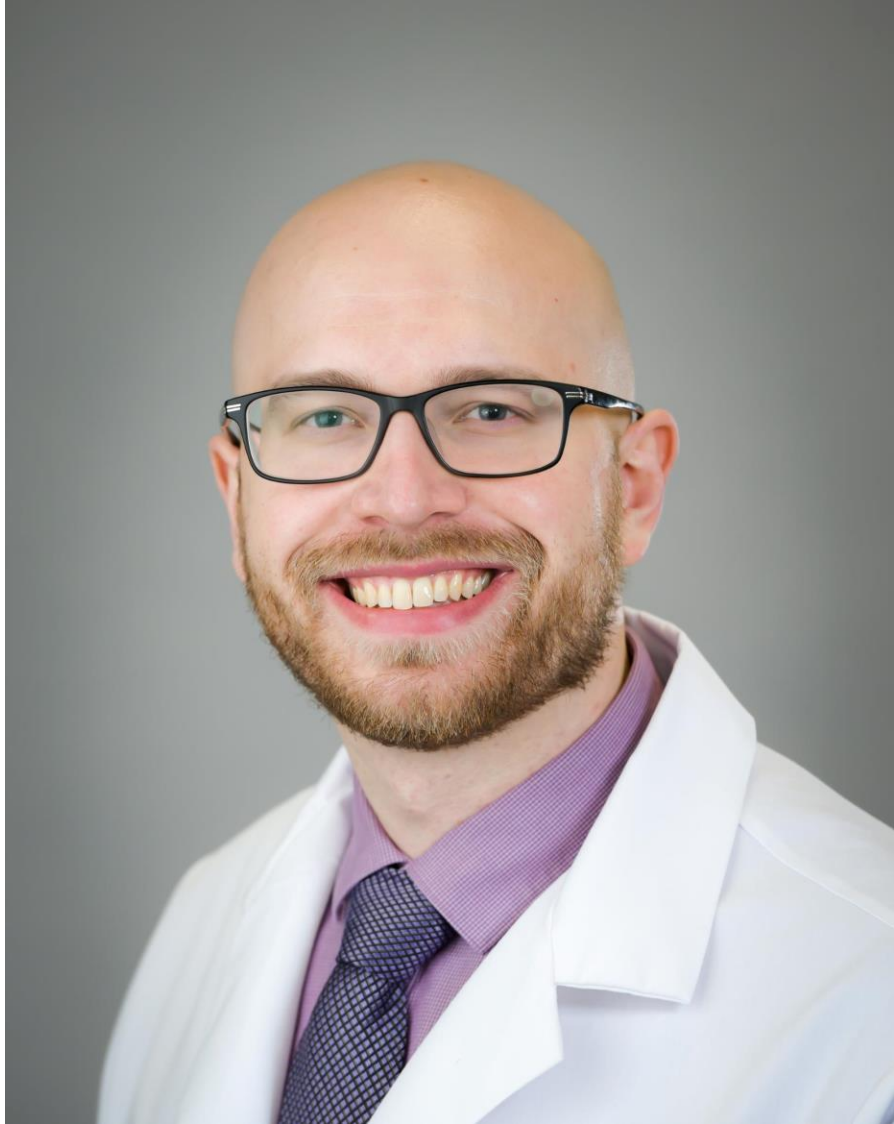


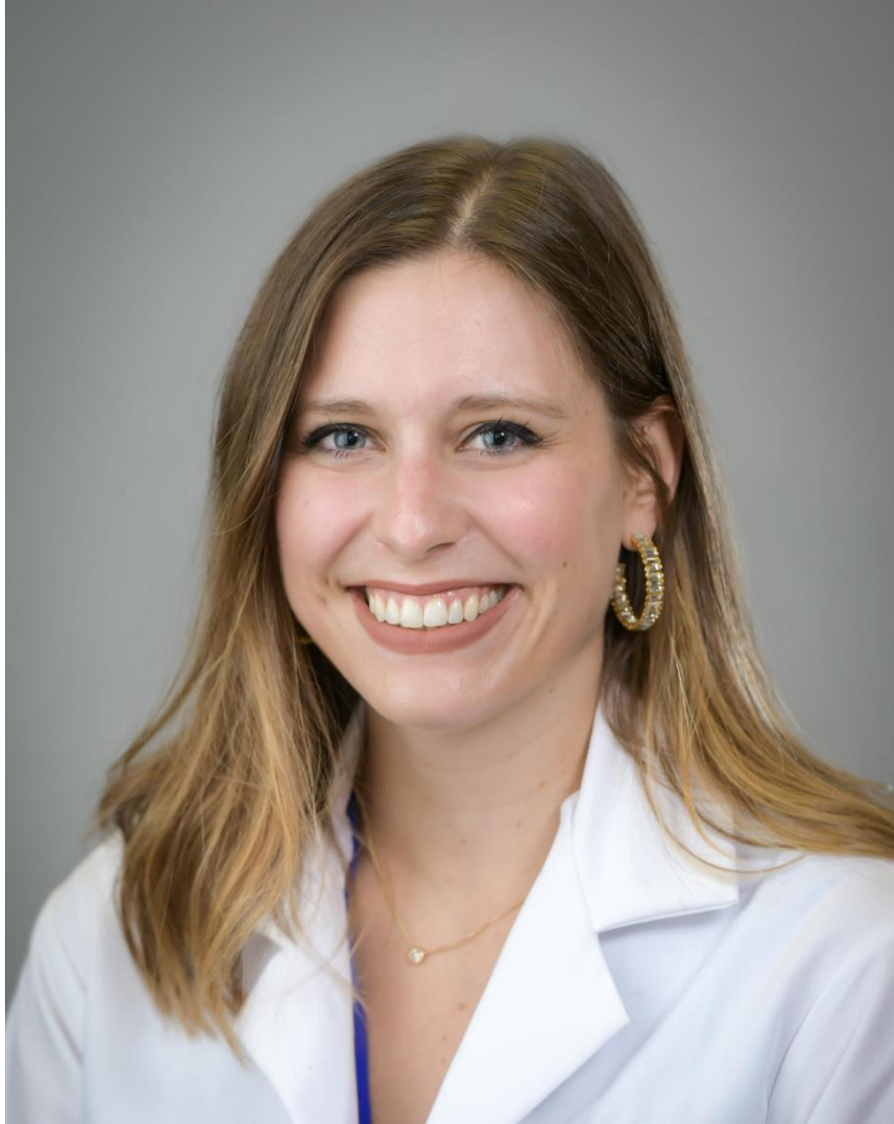

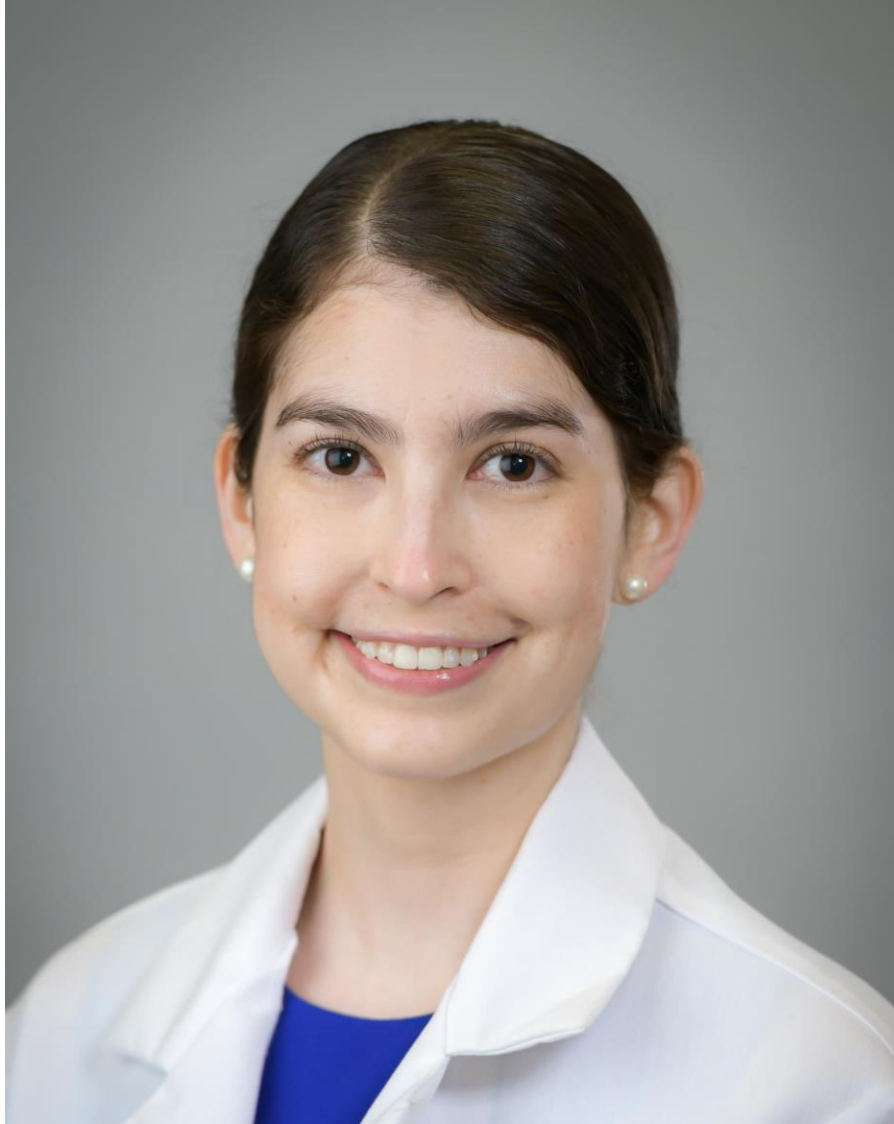
Ben Masserano MD

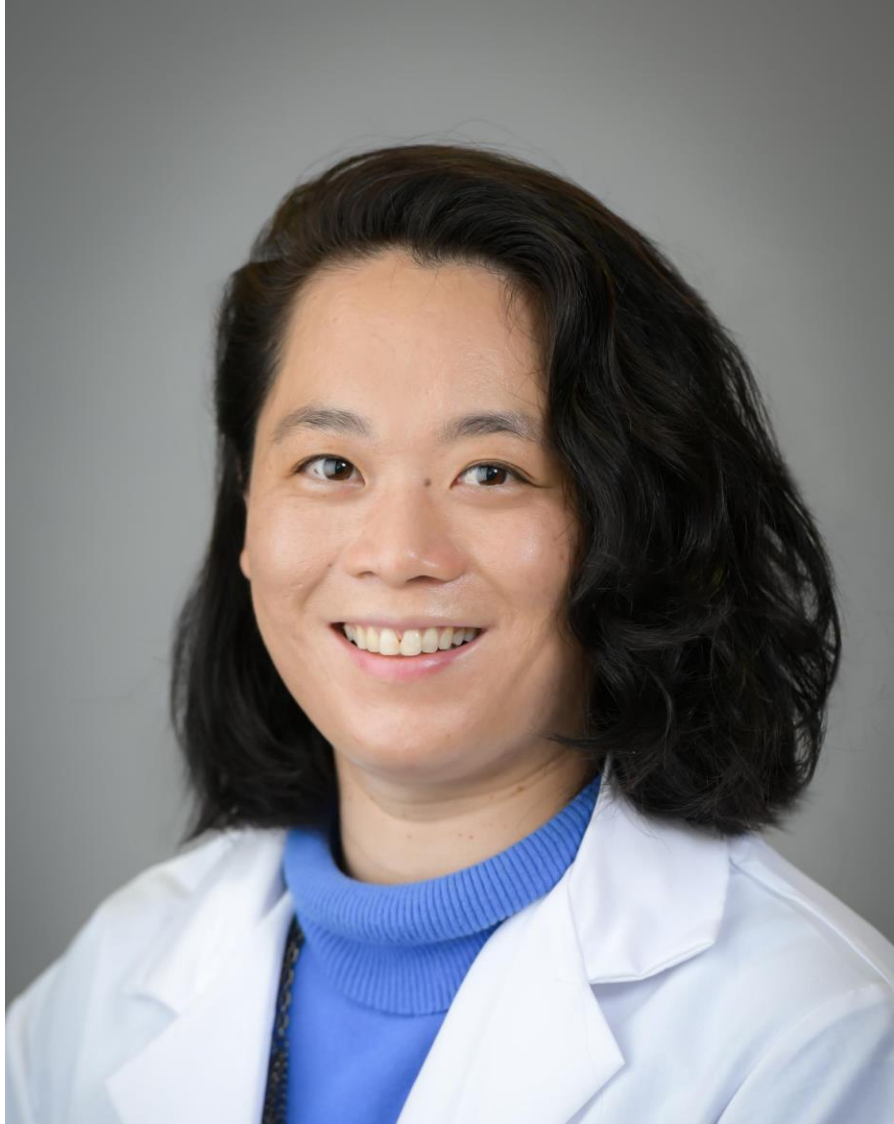
