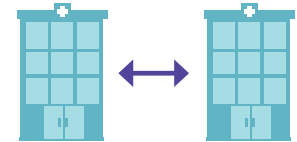

Points of Pride:

- **E.X.I.T. procedure** (special surgical procedure used to deliver babies that are high-risk due to lung and airway conditions)
- **Whole Body Therapeutic Hypothermia Program** (cooling the infant to 33°C suppresses the initial insult to the body and helps improve outcomes in 50% of cases)
- **THRIVE program** (cost savings of \$3,000 per child per year)
- **PDA Plug** (only program in North Texas to offer this in conjunction with cardiology, radiology and cardiothoracic surgery)
