



2017 KEY FACTS ABOUT CHILDREN'S HEALTH SPECIALTY CENTERS

Children's Health[™] provides care through several multidisciplinary Specialty Centers (outpatient clinics) throughout North Texas. Extending its outstanding care from its medical center hospitals through more than 50 pediatric specialty programs ranging from simple eye exams to specialized treatments in heart disease, endocrinology and cystic fibrosis.

SPECIALTY CENTER LOCATIONS

Children's Health Specialty Center Dallas (formerly Ambulatory Care Pavilion) is located at 2350 North Stemmons Freeway (I-35E), across the street from Children's Medical Center Dallas, the flagship hospital of Children's Health. This six-story facility was completely redesigned and renovated to provide patients and their families with easy access to a wide array of specialty outpatient services in one convenient location.

Children's Health Specialty Center 1 Plano provides outpatient care for children from birth to age 18. It is attached to Children's Medical Center Plano, which extends the world-class service of our system to families moving to North Texas and beyond. The specialty center offers the largest suburban group of pediatric specialists in the nation.

Specialty Center 2 Plano opened in December of 2017. The four-story center is home to an outpatient imaging center, surgery center, medical office building and the **Children's Health Andrews Institute for Orthopaedics & Sports Medicine**. As the only pediatric orthopaedic institute of its kind in Texas, the Institute aims to greatly reduce the number of children side-lined from injuries. The Institute offers expertise in: trauma and fracture care, experienced sports team physicians, groundbreaking research, injury prevention geared toward youth athletes, and rehabilitation and therapy. The center is also home to Sports Performance powered by EXOS.

Children's Health Specialty Center West Plano offers pediatric specialists that evaluate and treat patients in a warm, comfortable environment designed especially for children.

Children's Health Specialty Center Allen offers feeding therapy, occupational therapy, physical therapy, speech/language therapy, developmental screenings and equipment assessments in addition to parent education and support.

Children's Health Specialty Center Cityville opened in 2017 at Cityville Southwestern Medical District. It offers outpatient services including physical therapy, speech and language pathology, occupational therapy, aquatic therapy with a state-of the-art therapy pool, language and feeding therapy, vestibular programs, sensory integration and developmental therapy.

Children's Health Specialty Center Frisco offers occupational therapy, physical therapy, care coordination, developmental screenings and equipment assessments in addition to parent education and support.

Children's Health Specialty Center Grapevine offers occupational therapy, physical therapy, speech/language therapy, care coordination, developmental screenings and equipment assessments in addition to parent education and support.

Children's Health Specialty Center Las Colinas offers occupational therapy, physical therapy, speech/ language therapy, care coordination, developmental screenings and equipment assessments, in addition to parent education and support.

Children's Health Specialty Center Mesquite brings nationally-recognized pediatric care close to home for families living in the Mesquite area, offering physical medicine and rehabilitation.

Children's Health Specialty Center Park Cities (formally Children's Specialty Care Center at Texas Health *Resources*), is bringing the research and expertise of an academic medical center directly to families by providing exceptional care through a number of specialties including: neonatology, pediatric cardiology and cardiothoracic surgery, clinical nutrition, ear nose and throat, endocrinology, gastroenterology, general surgery, neurosurgery, urology, plastics and craniofacial surgery.

Children's Health Specialty Center Richardson brings exceptional pediatric care close to home to families in the Richardson area. Our specialty center is located at the CityLine Wellness Building with numerous subspecialties including: physical therapy, occupational therapy, speech language pathology, Autistic Behavior Therapy early intervention for Autism, Autistic Behavior Therapy outpatient clinic for Autism, and behavioral psychology clinic for children with Autism Spectrum Disorder.

Children's Health Specialty Center North Rockwall

offers occupational therapy, physical therapy, speech/language therapy, care coordination, developmental screenings and equipment assessments in addition to parent education and support.

Children's Health Specialty Center South Rockwall

is one of five locations in the Dallas-Fort Worth area serving the patients in the Children's Health pediatric urology program. This location provides evaluation, diagnosis, treatment and follow-up care to infants, children and adolescents.

Children's Health Specialty Center Tyler is located in the Louis & Peaches Owen Heart Hospital, and offers cardiac consultation and heart center services. This location also provides pediatric urology services.

Children's Health Specialty Center Waxahachie

offers occupational therapy, physical therapy, speech/language therapy, care coordination, developmental screenings and equipment assessments in addition to parent education and support.

Children's Health Specialty Center Bass Center

(formerly called Chase Building) offers the following outpatient specialties: dentistry, psychiatry and psychology, Applied Behavior Analysis and Autism and Developmental disabilities (CADD). The **Center for Autism & Developmental Disabilities** (CADD) is an interdisciplinary program offering comprehensive patient care and translational medicine for individuals with autism and related neurodevelopmental disorders. The Center is a joint endeavor between UT Southwestern Medical Center and Children's Health with additional collaboration from UT Dallas Callier Center for Communication Disorders, are critical to both our clinical and research missions. CADD is a single home for patients and families where multidisciplinary evaluation and treatment teams work alongside leading scientists utilizing state-ofthe-art approaches for understanding and treating neurodevelopmental disorders.

Children's Health Sleep Disorders Center is one of two dedicated pediatric sleep centers that are accredited by the Academy of Sleep Medicine and the only one in North Texas. The Sleep Disorders Center has three board certified specialists, a fellowship training program affiliated with UT Southwestern, and sleep technologists with backgrounds in neurophysiology, respiratory therapy and/or sleep technology. The center specializes in identifying and treating a range of sleep conditions.

In 2017, Our Children's House outpatient clinics rebranded to Children's Health Specialty Centers.
