The seasoned critical care staff are instructors for advanced clinical training such as PALS, ACLS and NRP. All crew receive ongoing invasive skills and critical care training to ensure expert clinical skills.

THE NEONATAL/ PEDIATRIC TRANSPORT TEAM AT CHILDREN'S:

- Transports more than 6,000 neonatal and pediatric patients annually.
- Offers physician consultation and referral support for ongoing patient management, even if the patient is not being transferred to Children's.
- Focuses on the family. One parent may accompany a child on transport.
- Provides third-party transfers between two referring facilities.

A PART OF THE TEAM

When an ill or injured neonate or child requires transfer for specialty care, the neonatal/pediatric transport team at Children's Medical Center is your facility's resource. The moment you call our transport team, Children's mobilizes our highly specialized mobile ICU medical services to give you, the caregiver, peace of mind, and to provide a patient and family's smooth transition between facilities.

At Children's, we provide a wide range of neonatal/pediatric specialty care. From basic life support to critical care, our renowned transport services will transfer patients by air or ground. We arrange transports locally, nationally or internationally. We were the first neonatal/pediatric specialty team in the United States to garner CAMTS accreditation in all three modes (fixed-wing, rotor-wing and ground), and the first in the United States with a jet solely dedicated to neonatal and pediatric transport.

MAKING CONTACT

Upon receiving your call, our communication specialists will contact the appropriate accepting physician, and will determine the mode of transportation based your patient's acuity. Once the transport team is activated, your facility may be connected with the accepting physician if needed. Upon arrival at your facility, our team will begin caring for the patient.
